

Palo Verde School Uniform Policy Update

Earlier this year we asked families to give input in continuing the school uniform policy at Palo Verde. Surveys were provided at conferences in both paper form and shared electronically by Google form. Palo Verde staff were surveyed and in depth discussions were held. Finally, current research was reviewed on the impact of school uniforms on student learning and behavior. **Based on the survey results, discussion, and analysis,** we will continue the Palo Verde uniform policy for the next school year (2023-2024). However, for the following school year (2024-2025), school uniforms will not be required. Please review the uniform policy at the conclusion of this letter which will be in place for next year.

If your child has outgrown your uniform clothing, or/and you would be willing to donate to students in need, please place them in the labeled box in the entry of Palo Verde. If you are struggling to provide clothing for your child that meets the uniform requirements, contact the Palo Verde office, nurse, or counselor. 2023-2024 Palo Verde School Uniform Policy

TOPS: Navy blue, red, white polo shirts. Long-sleeved collared shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters, and turtlenecks are options. Palo Verde spirit shirts are allowed on any day. ALL **undershirts** should be red, white or blue. *A+shirts* may be worn any day of the week

BOTTOMS: Dark navy blue pants, blue jeans, navy colored sweatpants, or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, capris, and jumpers are acceptable. Shorts, dresses, and skirts should be no less than six (6) inches above the top of the kneecap. Pants or shorts should not be embellished with sequins or lace and should be dark blue (not tie-dyed, not torn, or have holes).

SOCKS: Navy blue, white, or black **solid** colored socks, tights and leggings in these colors may be worn under jumpers or skirts.

SHOES: Closed-toe shoes are to be worn on P.E. days. Low-heeled sandals with a back strap are permitted, but flip-flops, slippers, shoes with a heel, and Crocs are not permitted (no Heelys allowed).

HATS: Hats may be worn outdoors, but are not to be worn in the building. Hats must be worn with the brim forward.

<u>OUTERWEAR:</u> During the cold weather months, any colored jacket, sweater, sweater vest, or sweatshirt is permitted. If a classroom as a whole, or an individual student is unusually cold, the teacher will allow the student to wear their jacket or coat while in the classroom as needed.

Every effort will be made to keep your child in school and make sure that they are wearing an acceptable version of the school uniform and dress code.
