


Instructional Minute Requirements

An Online Student :

Tips for Learning in an Online Class



Watch for communication from your teacher with class codes and access information.



Access your online courses using your Clever Badge/Account or Google login.



Establish a daily routine. Use your schedule from your teacher for learning.

Be sure to be online, on time, and actively participate with your camera on for the entire live session with your teacher and/or service provider.



Be familiar with your Google classroom, and stay updated on the expectations as well as any assignment/activity deadlines from your teacher.



Tour the online class or class website to become familiar with where to find assignments and activities. Click on all of the links and read the content.



Turn in all of your assignments on time.



• Log in and participate as



- The minimum levels of participation
- required by the teacher.
- Students who don't log in and/or submit assignments
 as required will be marked absent and subject to the 10-day drop procedures (Students enrolled in CGOLA will lose their spot if dropped.).

• To comply with state and federal attendance requirements, attendance will be taken by elementary teachers twice daily, and during each live class by middle school teachers. only satisfy attendance requirements.

 Class grades will be determined based on the completeness and accuracy of all assignments in combination with teacher feedback and student conferencing.
