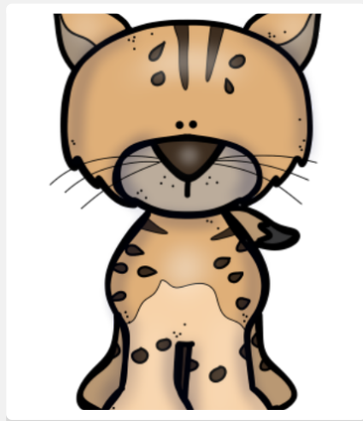

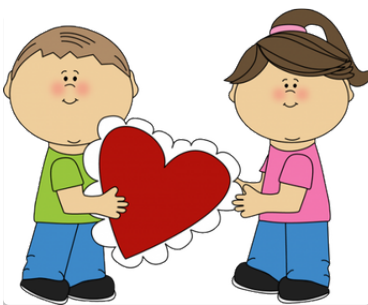
Lockdown Drill

Monday, February 13th, Cottonwood staff and students will conduct a "Lockdown Drill" at our school. Part of our safety and security measures suggests that all CGESD schools practice emergency drills throughout the school year. Our hope is that we will never have to use any safety measure, however it is important for us to practice so we are prepared for any circumstance.

A Lockdown Drill's actions are to move away from sight, maintain silence, lock classroom doors and turn out the lights.

When speaking to students about lockdown drills, teachers will talk in general terms, stating that "just like we practice fire drills and have to leave the building, we also need to practice for emergencies that will keep us in the building." Talking about the drill with your children at home may also help alleviate unnecessary anxiety.

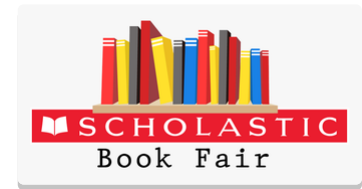


Friendship Day Parties
