## FRIENDLY REMINDERS

## ATTENDANCE REMINDERS

#### **School Hours**

- School begins at 7:45 am. Students arriving after 7:45am need to be signed in by a parent.
  Students arriving after this time are considered tardy.
- School ends at 3:00 pm. Students that are picked up prior to this time are marked absent for the time they are out of school.

#### **Absence Reporting**

- For student safety students should not be on campus before 7:15am.
- Due to Arizona state guidelines absences MUST be called in on the DAY OF the student's absence to mark them as excused.
- Excused absences are: illness, doctor appointment, bereavement or family emergency.
- All other absences are considered Unexcused.
- Leave Early- students that are picked up early from school are marked ABSENT for the time they are absent from class.
- Except in emergencies, students cannot be signed out after 2:30PM.
