Did You Know...

The devices checked out to the student (iPads and Chromebooks) are for school work only. They are not for personal or entertainment use. This includes gaming websites and YouTube. You can monitor your child's activity in two ways.

First, check their browsing history.

- On a Chromebook, while in the web browser, click on the three vertical dots under the X in the top right corner. Click "History" then "History" again. It will take you to a list of the activity which cannot be deleted.
- On an iPad, go to the Safari browser, and select the book icon at the top by the address bar. Then tap the clock that appears below it. This will show the websites visited each day.
