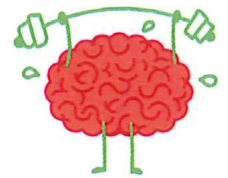
Engage Your Child Throughout the Summer

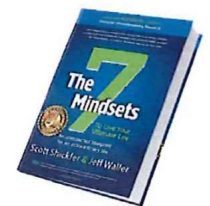
