

Dear Families,

It is great to be back together in school! We follow safety procedures throughout the day and refrain from mixing students. Time for socializing and social emotional learning takes place each day in addition to academics. Your children mean the world to us.

Report cards and academic progress will be shared with families during online parent/teacher conferences March 11 and 12. Please note that early dismissal is at 12:00 noon for students that attend the center-based program and 12:30 for students attending general education classrooms.
