Desert Willow Elementary School Dress Code

The district encourages students to take pride in their attire as it relates to school. Students should dress in a manner that, in addition to the following guidelines, takes into consideration the educational safety, health, and welfare to self and others.

- Shorts and skirts must be long enough to reach the students' palms with arms at one's sides and be appropriate length for school.
- Bare midriffs, halter tops, strapless and spaghetti straps are <u>not</u> to be worn.
- Shoes must be worn at all times. Flip flops are not allowed and tennis shoes are required for PE.
- Jewelry may not be worn if it presents a safety hazard to self and/or others. Body piercing jewelry, other than earrings is prohibited.
- Profane, offensive or defamatory writing or pictures on clothing or jewelry is not acceptable.
- No hats, bandanas, "colors", items with price tags visible or other gang related apparel is permitted.
- Clothing with obscene language or symbols, symbols of drugs, sex or alcohol is prohibited.
- Pants must be worn at the waist.
- Distracting hair color or style, make-up, artificial finger nails, and temporary and permanent tattoos are also prohibited.
- No see through clothing is allowed.

Students who come to school in violation of the school dress code will be required to contact parents to secure appropriate clothing. Repeated dress code violations will result in additional disciplinary actions.
