As part of CGESD's effort to make digital learning resources accessible to our students, your child has received this device to take part in learning activities. Here are tips to help you get started with your child's new CGESD-issued device.

> How to create a good study space for learning

- A well-lit area (natural light is best)
- Comfortable sitting and table top height
- Near a power outlet for charging
- Choose a guiet location that prevents distractions
- Keep learning materials and supplies organized and at hand

> Internet access

- WiFi is accessible in the parking lots of:
 - Cholla Elementary-Parking lot between Cholla & Cactus
 - CGMS/Saguaro- Auditorium parking lot facing Pinal Ave

- Hotspot devices may be available from your school site for short-term check out.

Clever

iPads-Log into the app using the printed badge

Chromebooks- Log into the device using the printed badge.

Clever is a tool we use to provide single sign-on and quick links to frequently used apps.

We will use Clever with K-1st grade students to share assignments and access links for virtual class discussions



Google Classroom

Click on the Classroom icon in Clever and it will log the student into the Google Classroom app. Alternatively, go to https://classroom.google.com

and log in with your Google username and password.



Nearpod

Nearpod is an interactive teaching tool that allows teachers to present content and students to interact in either live or independent sessions.

Teachers will provide join codes to Nearpod lessons through Clever, Google Classroom, or during a live session.






Google Username: firstinitial+lastname+last4StudentID@caesd.ora

Google Password: firstname+last4studentID

- If a student has punctuation in their first or last name (e.g. 'or -), it will not be in their username.
- Temporary Password to Google- Students will be prompted to change this on first login to Google.
- If a student has punctuation in their first name (e.g. 'or -), it will be in their password as well.
- If a student's first name is less than 4 letters, add! or!! to the end of the password (passwords must be 8 characters minimum).

How To Clean Your District Electronics

Please reach out to your teacher if you have any questions or concerns about cleaning your district electronics.



- Make sure the Electronic is unplugged and turned off
- Use Lysol wipes or an equivalent
 - The equivalent should have the active ingredients: Alkyl C14 (50%), C12 (40%), C16 (10%) Dimethyl Benzyl Ammonium Chloride (0.26%). Other Ingredients: (99.74%).
- Spray cloth with permitted cleaning substance
- Use a slightly damp cloth
- Use a 50/50 Isopropyl Rubbing Alcohol & Water mix
- Air dry device before reusing
- Clean Regularly



- Do NOT use Bleach
- Do NOT use Ammonia
- Do NOT spray cleaner directly onto electronic device
- Do **NOT** submerge in water
- Do NOT use a dripping wet cloth: you should NOT be able to squeeze out any liquids
- Do NOT vacuum your computer
- Do NOT eat or drink next to your electronics
- Do NOT remove the keys or any other removable parts
- Do **NOT** use 100%
 Isopropyl Rubbing Alcohol
- Do **NOT** wipe excessively
- Do NOT get moisture into the openings
