

Distance Learning Brief



All students enrolled in CGESD will begin distance learning starting Monday, August 17, 2020.

- CGESD Distance learning is available to students in Pre-K - 8th Grade.
- Students will work from home on their District issued device five days per week. They will also be provided assignments that do not require screen time.
- Individual and small group instruction will take place remotely.
- Students need to make daily contact with their teacher via phone, Google Classroom, Zoom classroom meetings, or other means to maintain enrollment. Daily attendance is required by law.
- If students are ill or not participating, the parent or guardian shall call the school office and follow attendance procedures.
- Students in grades K-5 are expected to participate in music and PE classes.
- Students in grades 6-8 are expected to participate in the elective courses assigned.
- Social and emotional supports will be embedded into daily lessons. School counselors will also be available for large and small group supports.
- Students with disabilities will receive special education services through virtual instruction.
- Students receiving English Learning supports will receive services through virtual instruction.
- Meals will continue to be served following the National School Lunch Program guidelines.
